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MEDICAL DISCLAIMER

The Mangrove Tree Academy Inc will not have medical personnel on staff this coming summer. We will closely be following the updated 2021 summer camp health and safety guidelines set forth by Department of Health. We will be adhering to any protocols and best practices in accordance with the guidelines for camps to ensure the ongoing safety of all campers and staff. Dependent on the most updated 2021 camp guidelines, these may include:

- Staff and campers must wear face coverings when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Campers will be screened each morning for fever and any other COVID related symptoms prior to being admitted into our facility.
- Campers will be socially distanced by 3' in classrooms and camp groups will be limited in size to accommodate this distance.
- Classrooms, bathrooms and touch points will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the day.

In the event a camper complains of feeling ill, or displays symptoms of the COVID virus, the parent/guardian or emergency contact will be called and asked to pick up their child as soon as possible from the camp. We are also entrusting the parent/guardian that if your child, or any household member, is displaying signs of COVID or has tested positive, you do not send your child to camp until it is safe to do so.

In the event of a minor cut or injury, a member of our staff will apply ointment, Band-Aids or an ice pack. If a camper complains of feeling ill (non COVID related), the parent/guardian or emergency contact will be called and asked to pick up their child as soon as possible. In the event of a severe injury or medical emergency, a staff member will call 911 immediately and a parent/guardian will also be notified immediately. The Mangrove Tree Academy Inc Day Camp will not administer any medication to our campers.
